CHURCH GROWTH PARTNERSHIP

PURPOSE

A Church Growth Partnership is between a church in the United States and an indigenous church in Central America facilitated by Commissioned International. While the U.S. church strengthens their global mission efforts, the indigenous church is strengthened to be salt and light in their communities. Our role is to facilitate this mutually edifying partnership between both churches.

GOALS

The ultimate goal for this initiative is to grow and strengthen both churches, multiply disciples, and expand church planting to fulfill The Great Commission. Expounding on this idea, our goals are:

- To see spiritual formation at all levels and with all involved, as well as the numerical growth of the church where God allows
- To provide a sustainable solution to chronic problems and focus on moving from relief-style aid to achieving development within a community
- To walk alongside indigenous churches and help them be selfsustaining in their context, as they grow into ministry hubs for their communities and a light to the world.
- To bring these three groups together to foster a relationship of trust to achieve long-term success

GLOBAL DISCIPLESHIP AND CHURCH PLANTING INSTITUTE


PURPOSE

Equipping pastors with theological education and practical skills to fulfill The Great Commission is at the core of who we are. We firmly believe the health and impact of an indigenous church are directly connected to the passion and training its pastor receives. Moving forward, we have a vision to expand the ongoing ministries of our bible institutes.

GOALS

The goal is to develop a Global Discipleship and Church Planting Institute with multiple training tracks in the various countries that we serve. Our intent is to equip men with a theological foundation to teach God's word and the strategies to establish self-sustaining indigenous churches.





THE COMMISSIONED INITIATIVE

PURPOSE

In Fall 2025, we will launch The Commissioned Initiative, a fundraising initiative to provide the resources to shape the future of Commissioned International. God has provided for every need we have had through the sacrificial generosity of donors. We believe that the stage is set to step into the future that God has in store for Commissioned International.

GOALS

This initiative aims to raise \$400,000 annually for the next three years, totaling \$1.2 million. These funds will be used for various purposes, including developing a Global Discipleship and Church Planting Institute, expanding our ministry into other countries, orphan prevention programs, and necessary renovations to our headquarters.
